

Lois R. Bolton

A memorial service will be held at a later date for Lois Ruth Bolton who died at Diamond Point March 30, 1993 at the age of 84.

Mrs. Bolton was born September 24, 1908 at Salina, Kan. to Guy Debell and Nettie Ethel Balmer Livingston. She was raised at Salina and graduated from Topeka High School in 1927. She moved to San Diego in 1928, working in retail sales until 1931.

She married Robert Brashear Bolton on December 25, 1931 at San Diego. They later moved to Los Angeles, where she helped her husband operate a small trucking business. They lived in several Southern California locations before starting

a construction company when they moved to Diamond Point in 1965. They retired in 1971.

Mrs. Bolton was a 10-year member of Trinity United Methodist Church and the Rhododendron Grange.

She is survived by a daughter, Eugnia Bolton Stull of Sequim; sons, Robert Bolton, Jr. of Covina, Calif. and Lowell Bolton of Glendora, Calif.; nine grandchildren, eight great-grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.
