

Edna E. Chrisman

SEQUIM — Memorial services for Edna E. Chrisman, 89, of Diamond Point will be at 1:30 p.m. today at the Gardiner Grange Hall on Highway 101 with the Rev. John Morgan of the Gardiner community Church presiding. She died Thursday, Oct. 17, 1996, at home.

Mrs. Chrisman was born Oct. 19, 1906, in Denton, Neb., to Gottfried and Anna Larson Hedvall. She grew up in Nebraska and married Orville J. Chrisman in 1926. They moved to Seattle in 1936 and to Diamond Point in 1965. He died in 1975.
