Memorial services for Vincent H. Hodis, 74, of Sequim, will be at 11 a.m. Wednesday at the Rhododendron Grange Hall. Past Grange master Einar Forsman will officiate. Mr. Hodis died Friday, March 2, 1990, in Port Angeles.

He was born Dec. 7, 1915, in the Bronx, N. Y. to Louis and Matilda Kasendeck Hodis. He was raised in Coventry, Conn., and attended Montana State University. He served in the Army Air Corps from 1940 to 1945.
