

NORMAN PAUL JOHNSON

SEQUIM — A memorial service for Norman Paul Johnson, 72, will be at 1:30 p.m. Thursday in Faith Lutheran Church with the Rev. Walter A. Huth officiating. Mr. Johnson died at home Monday. There was cremation under direction of Sequim Valley Chapel with inurnment in the Gardiner Cemetery.

He was born in Omaha, Neb., Feb. 12, 1912, the son of David E. and Nellie P. Johnson. He was a graduate of North High School in Omaha. On Feb. 13, 1938, he and Mary Bigelow were married at Plattsmouth, Neb.

The couple moved to Sequim in 1977 from Omaha where Mr. Johnson had been an insurance salesman and a United States Mail carrier. He served in the Navy during World War II and belonged to Faith Lutheran Church and in Omaha to the American Lutheran Church. He also belonged to the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 4760 and Rhododendron Grange 1137.

In addition to his wife, Mary, he is sur-

vived by a son, Robert Paul Johnson of Seattle; daughter, Major Maralee Jane Johnson, USMC, of Alexandria, Va.; a sister, Eleanor L. Johnson of Omaha; and one granddaughter.
