Sequim Valley Funeral Chapel was in charge of cremation.

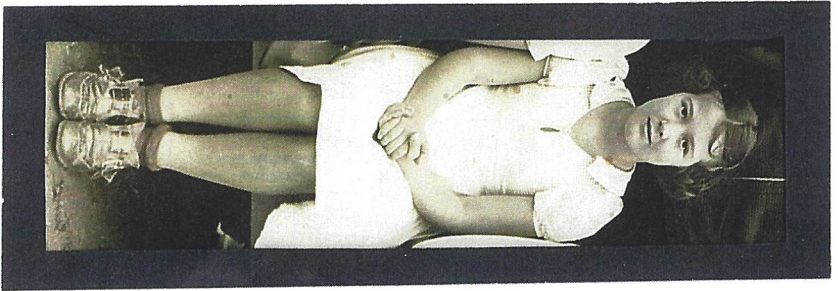

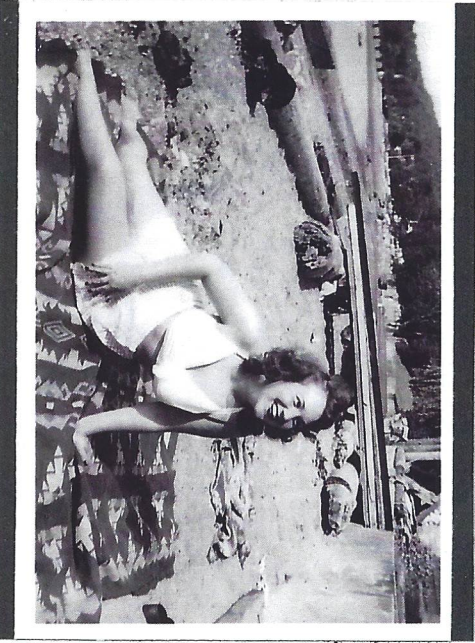

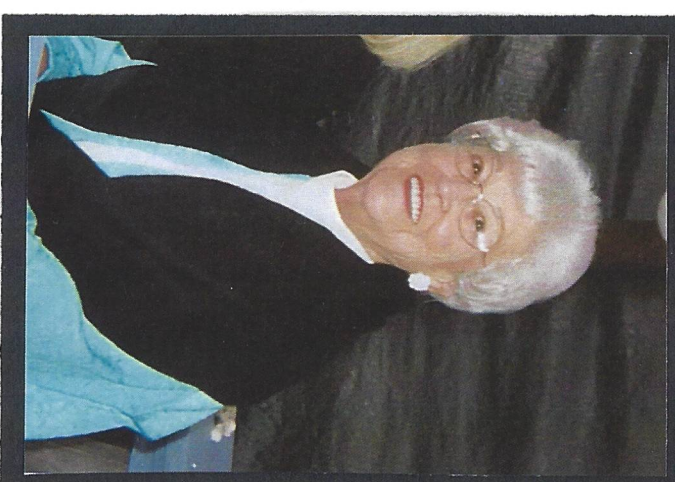




Dear Fern,
