

Cassie V. McNeely

A service was held for Cassie Vernam McNeely on Friday, Oct. 12, at Trinity United Methodist Church, conducted by Dr. Roger Barr. She died October 8.

Mrs. McNeely was born September 30, 1909 in Freedom, Neb. to Frank and Lorna Vernam, who were homesteaders in Iowa and Nebraska. Her father operated the general store and served as postmaster. She succeeded him as postmistress in the late 1940's.

She moved to Medford, Ore. in the 1950's where she married Ross J. McNeely, of Kelso, in 1959. He retired from the U.S. Postal Service about 1961. They moved to Diamond Point shortly after, and then to Sequim in the early 1970's. He died in 1975.

Mrs. McNeely was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church and numerous organizations, including the Grange, Friends of the Library, the Stamp Club, and Monday Musicales.

She is survived by: a stepson, a stepgrandson, four grandnieces, two grandnephews, and one great-grandniece.
