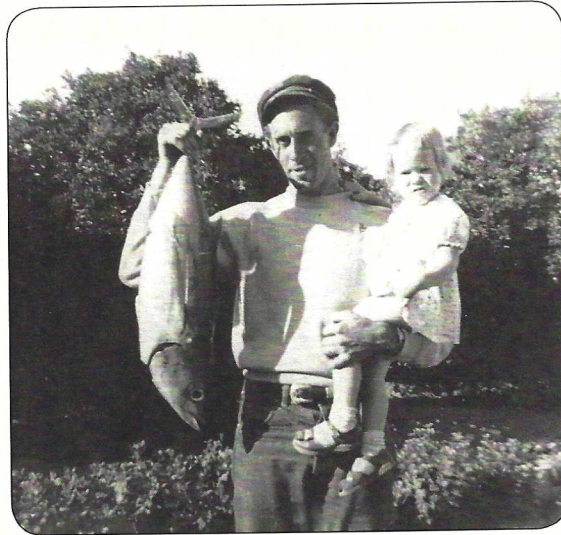
Miles P. Nesbitt

Miles P. Nesbitt died of an extended illness at home in Diamond Point. He was 87.

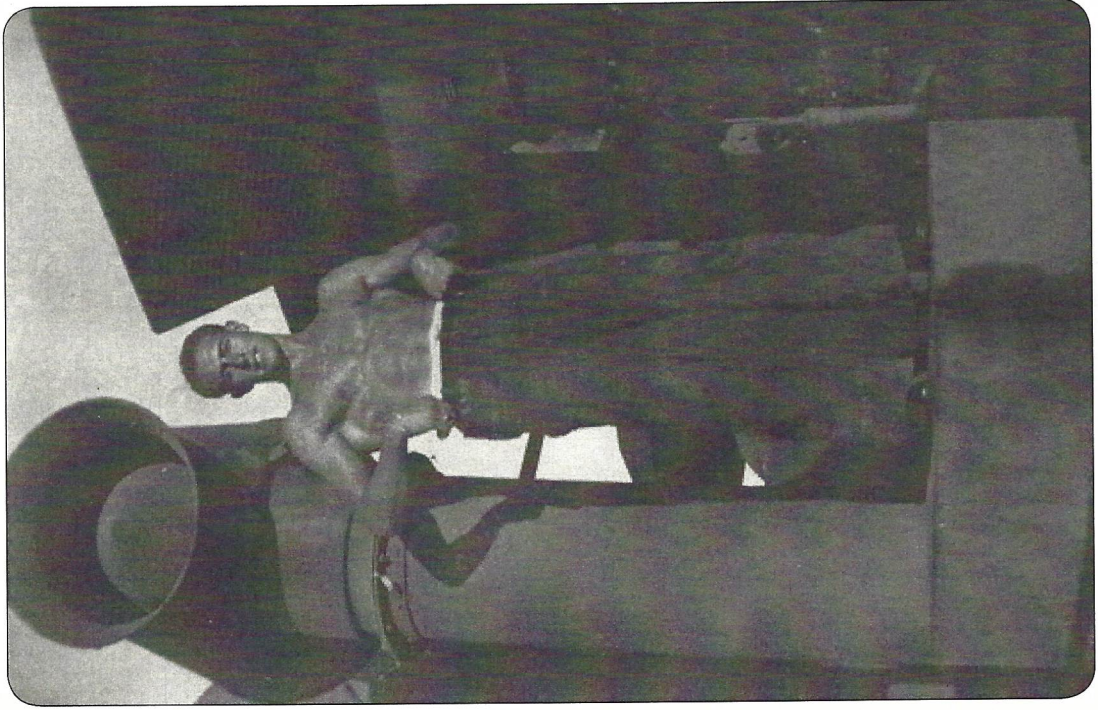
