

## Corenne S. Placek

No funeral service was held for Corenne S. Placek, age 84, at her request. A memorial service will be held at Gardiner Community Hall at 1 p.m. Friday, Nov. 17.

Ms. Placek was born May 21, 1905 at Wahoo, Neb. to Emil and Elizabeth Placek, and died November 10, 1989 in Sequim.
