

# Floyd Niles Slover

Floyd Niles Slover, a retired career air force serviceman, died at his Gardiner home June 25 at the age of 54.

Mr. Slover was born April 3, 1934 at Osage, MN, the son of Carol and Vernon Stover. He married Rowena June Smith April 15, 1955 at Springfield, MA. He served in the air force 22 years, including tours of duty in Korea and Vietnam. He retired in 1972. He was warehouse supervisor with Mayflower Worldwide Movers in Anchorage, AK. Retiring from that post in 1983 when he moved to Gardiner.

He was an avid hunter and fisherman, a member of Rhododendron Grange in Gardiner, and served with Fire District No. 5—Gardiner, Discovery Bay—as a volunteer fireman.
