Sequim resident Lois L. Tatum died in Olympic Medical Center, Port Angeles, at age 83.

She was born to Daniel and Marjorie (Martin) Giard in Kennewick, which was her home for more than 40 years.

She served in the Navy during World War II and married William "Bill" Tatum in Pensacola, Fla., on Feb. 10, 1945.

The Tatums moved to Gardiner in 1970 and to Sequim in 1998.
